Recently, CHS students competed at the SSV rowing regatta in Geelong. All students rowed extremely well, competing against more experienced rowers.

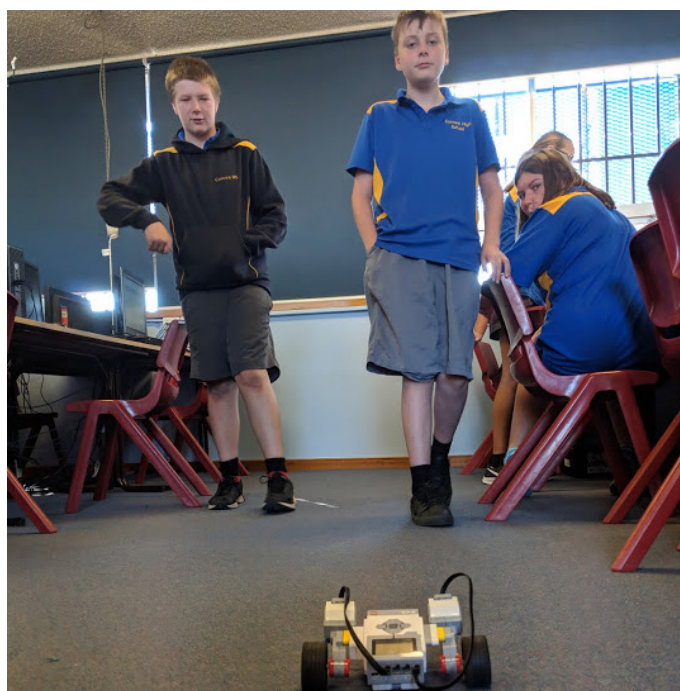
Thank you to rowing coach, Wes Canny, for donating his time to coach our students. Thanks also to Robert Evers and the parents for providing transportation and support throughout the day.

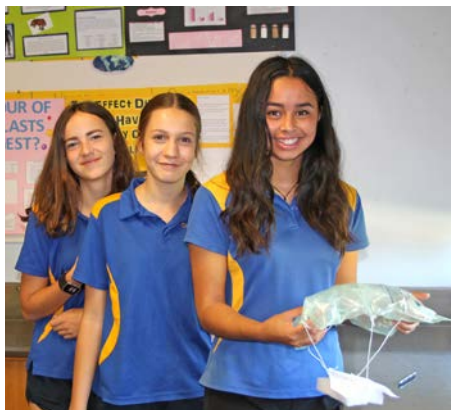
