School Chaplain, Ms Jongeneel, organised an international breakfast for students in celebration of Harmony week in March.

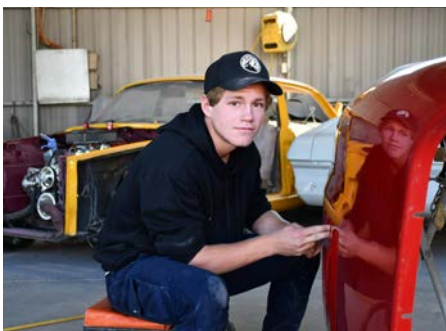
Students were encouraged to sample traditional food from many countries including the Philippines, Greece, Australia, France and many others.
